End Liquor Prohibition:

This is Jan Suraaj's most prominent and specific promise. Prashant Kishor has repeatedly vowed to end the state's liquor ban immediately upon forming a government.

Economic Revival Plan:

This revenue would then be used as collateral to secure massive development loans (reportedly ₹5 to 6 lakh crore) from institutions like the World Bank and IMF to fund statewide infrastructure and industrial projects.

Stopping Forced Migration:

A core goal is to create sufficient economic opportunities and jobs within Bihar so that residents are no longer forced to migrate for low-wage jobs.

Support for Women Entrepreneurs:

A pledge to provide financial aid to women who want to start their own businesses, at interest rates lower than those offered by existing programs like Jeevika.

"Clean" Candidates:

A key part of the Jan Suraaj "promise" is its candidate selection. The party has fielded candidates from diverse backgrounds, including doctors, professors, and former bureaucrats, based on merit and a "clean image" rather than traditional political affiliations.
